Our eleven-person team funded more than 4 houses in Tarija, Bolivia:

| Each team member donated \$350 for construction supplies | 1 house |
|---|-----------|
| Eleven team members working for 9 days saved masons' wages that the Tarija affiliate can use for other projects | ½ house |
| A smooth trip resulted in a donation to the Tarija affiliate of the \$6,000 remaining in contingency reserves | 1½ houses |
| Vigorous optional fund raising by team members generated additional donations | 1½ houses |

Although $4\frac{1}{2}$ houses is a remarkable accomplishment for an eleven-person team, look at what will happen over the next 8 to 10 years:

| The homeowners will make monthly mortgage payments into the Revolving Fund for Humanity that is used to build more houses $_$ $_$. | 41/2 houses |

| Similarly, all these additional homeowners will make mortgage payments that will build even more houses, and so on | 4½ houses |

Therefore, at least 9, or 12, or maybe even more families will come to live in decent housing as a direct result of the efforts of one eleven-person Global Village team.
